"Baustelle Fortschritt. Emil Zbinden und der Staumauerbau Grimsel-Oberaar"

15 March to 19 August 2018

Alpine Museum of Switzerland, Biwak#21

Emil Zbinden spent the summer months from 1950 to 1953 in the Bernese Alps, in the Grimsel region. On Oberaar, together with his artist friends Eugen Jordi and Rudolf Mumprecht, he drew the towering dam wall and portrayed the workers. Photographers, including Jakob Tuggener and Anita Niesz, also travelled to the huge construction site near the glacier. The bivouac exhibition in the Alpine Museum of Switzerland gathered this largely unpublished pictorial material and put it up for discussion again in 2018. The exhibition was curated by Jürg Spichiger and Etienne Wismer. The installation by the Zurich artist group CKÖ dealt with the material concrete in the independent art space Grand Palais and supplemented the show in the Alpine Museum with a perspective of contemporary art. The finissage of the exhibitions took place on the Oberaar dam at around 2,300 metres above sea level.

„L'Albigna di Emil Zbinden“

6 June - 20 October

Ciäsa Granda Museum, Stampa, Val Bregaglia

The exhibition was dedicated to the beginning of the construction of the Albigna dam in the 1950s. It showed tempera, watercolours and subsequent woodcuts by Emil Zbinden from the years 1956 to 1959. Parallel to this, photographs by Urs Beyeler were shown in the Galleria il Salice in Castasegna.

The exhibition was curated by Jürg Spichiger and Etienne Wismer and was part of a project that included 2018 exhibitions at the Swiss Alpine Museum in Bern and the Grand Palais.

As part of the exhibition project, former workers, engineers and women working in the canteen were interviewed. Selected interviews were presented in the exhibition. In April 2015, the Italian-language television station RSI RETE DUE broadcast a number of interviews from the Storia Orale project.

The exhibition featured designs and sketches by Emil Zbinden on works by C.A. Loosli and on the subject of poor children as bonded farm labour. Zbinden and Loosli were friends and shared a similar view of world affairs. Emil Zbinden designed three dialect works by C. A. Loosli for Scherz Verlag and Büchergilde Gutenberg and provided them with wood engraving illustrations. One of these books (Mys Ämmital) has been newly published by Rotpunktverlag.
